



Nappy Changing Procedure

Prior to commencing nappy changing, the area should be safe and clear from any obstructions; the changing mat should be cleaned with anti-bacterial spray.

- Each child's individual changing equipment e.g. nappy, wipes, cream ect, should be gathered before child is taken into changing area. (N.B nappy cream register must be signed before cream can be applied)
- All staff should wear protective clothing provided e.g. disposable gloves, disposable apron.
- You should ensure correct moving and handling procedure is followed when lifting child up to changing mat.
- Soiled nappies and wipes should be placed in nappy sacks, before disposing of them in the nappy waste unit.
- Remove child from area before cleaning area with anti-bacterial spray, remove and discard gloves and apron in nappy waste unit

This procedure should be carried out with each nappy change.
