Baby room 1 have been focusing on healthy food where they have been tasting a range of different fruit and vegetables. Whilst tasting and exploring the fruit and vegetables they have also been talking about the different colours.

The children have also been exploring the garden where they have been digging in the mud, planting and splashing in the puddles.

The baby room have also started reading the book, *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* as their book of the month. They will be doing arts and crafts for this book including printing with fruit and vegetables.

Baby room 2 have been looking at spring animals and new beginnings. To link in with new beginnings their song of the month is *Baa Baa Black Sheep* and their story of the month is *Little Lamb*.

The baby room have also been focusing on some of the children's interests in the room. They have set up a hairdressers and pamper station where they have been exploring different accessories.

The 2-3 room have been developing their fine motor skill by taking part in a variety of different activities including balancing eggs and placing pipe cleaners through a colander.

They are currently exploring spring animals. They are identifying what animals live on farms, the noises they make and exploring a variety of resources that could be found on a farm. The house corner has been changed into a farm shop where the children are getting to explore a variety of fresh food items.

To continue with the animal theme in the playroom, the children are singing *Old McDonald had a Farm* and are reading the story *Cocka-Moo-Moo*

The 3-5s enjoyed a visit from the fire service where they got to sit in the fire engine, try on their hats, and spray water from the hose.

The children in the 3-5s have continued to help develop the garden by planting more flowers. They have also enjoyed watching the growing of the potato plants in the playroom.

Over the next month the 3-5s will be working on numeracy. If parents and children can look for numbers in and around their environment i.e car registration plates, buses, house numbers.
